Amsinckia micrantha – c.100 plants, margin of barley field, Churchill, SO8779. Brett Westwood (BW)

Anisantha diandra — widespread on tracksides and in set-aside, Blackstone SO7974, and Droppingwells Farm N.R. SO8074
Anthriscus caucalis — small patch, lane bank, Dunley, SO7869
Bromopsis inermis — scattered along verge of A4103, Leigh Sinton, SO7851

Carex binervis - Lion Wood, SP0871. ML

Centaurea cyanus – several scattered plants probably originating from old seed-bank, set-aside, Droppingwells Farm N.R., Kidderminster, SO8074

 $\it Cerastium\ arvense-c.10$  plants, grassy hillside, Fairy Glen, Ismere, SO8680. BW

*Colchicum autumnale* – 15 plants, road verge, Bickley, SO6371 *Cyperus eragrostis* – scattered on waste ground, Barnard's Green, SO7845

 $C.\ longus$  – small patch in marshy grassland, Clifton upon Teme, SO7161

Cystopteris fragilis – not found at either of two known sites (railway bridge at Bayton, SO6873, since 1978; wall in Malvern, SO7745, since 2001) and now believed to be extinct in the county Datura stramonium – scattered on margin of arable, Dunley,

SO7869; frequent in arable crop, Holt Heath, SO8262

*Eriophorum angustifolium* – expanding large patch in pool, Penny Hill Quarry, Martley, SO7561

*Erodium moschatum* – large plant in gutter, Newfield Rd., Hagley, SO9079. BW

Filipendula vulgaris – Baynhall Meadows, SO9853. M. Liley (ML) Geranium columbinum – scattered along verge of A451, Great Witley, SO7566

G. rotundifolium – small quantity, sandy bank, Astley Cross, SO8069

Glyceria fluitans x G. notata (G. x pedicellata) – present in garden pond for at least 30 years, Stoke Bliss, SO6463

*Hieracium scotostictum* – few plants only as colony virtually destroyed by early shaving of lane bank, Rochford, SO6367 *H. sublepistoides* – c. 120 plants, wooded bank, Wissett's Wood, SO6772. Large increase in population

 $\ensuremath{\textit{Hypochaeris glabra}} - 100s$  of plants, sandy field, Blackstone N.R., SO8074. BW

*Kickxia elatine* – scattered along arable margin, Nash Elm, SO7781 (VC39 Worcs.)

Lamium hybridum – common in arable crop, Holt Heath, SO8262 Lepidium campestre – scattered on soil heap, Holt Heath, SO8262 L. ruderale – small quantity, verge of A4538, Egdon, SO9151 Leucojum vernum – several scattered plants on trackside bank, Stanford Bridge, SO7165

*Lysimachia vulgaris* – few plants, Dean Brook, SO9360 *Neottia nidus-avis* – two plants, woodland, Penny Hill, SO7561; 17 plants, wooded lane bank Eastham, SO6767

Nemesia sp. (probably N. denticulata) – single casual plant, pavement, Stourbridge, SO8983. BW

Oxalis stricta – several plants, carpark, New Mill Bridge, Shelsley Beauchamp, SO7262

Paris quadrifolia – few large patches, woodland, Penny Hill, Martley, SO7561

*Phalaris minor* – introduced as part of stewardship scheme, Stanford Bridge, SO7165

Poa angustifolia – few plants, waste ground, Penny Hill Quarry, Martley, SO7561

Polypogon monspeliensis – common on soil heap, Holt Heath, SO8262

*Populus nigra* ssp. *betulifolia* – two trees by Grimley Brook, Grimley, SO8361

P. x mixta (Potentilla anglica x P. reptans) – few large patches, track, Penny Hill Quarry, Martley, SO7561. Det. M. Wilcox

Rosa corymbifera x R. squarrosa (R. x hemitricha) – field hedge, Frog End Meadow, Stoke Bliss, SO649634,(VC36 Worcs.), 9-7-20: VC36/37 boundary field hedge, Acton Beauchamp, SO681507, 10-7-20: scrub, Penny Hill, Quarry, Martley, SO752617, 15-7-20: field hedge, Nash Elm, SO778816, (VC39 Staffs.), 14-8-20: woodland margin, Puckhill Wood, SO935602, RM & G.A. Knass, 17-8-20. First county records.

*R. corymbifera* x *R. vosagiaca* – field hedge, Acton Beauchamp, SO691493, 10-7-20: scrub, Penny Hill Quarry, Martley, SO751612, RM & G.A. Knass, 18-8-20. First county records.

*R. micrantha* (female) x *R. corymbifera* – VC36/37 boundary field hedge, Acton Beauchamp, SO682507, 10-7-20. First county record. *R. tomentella* x *R. tomentosa* – scrub on field margin, SO712616, 10-9-19, and field hedge, SO711623, 17-8-20, Clifton upon Teme. First county records

Rumex conglomeratus x R. maritimus – scattered, marshy lagoon, Longdon Marsh N.R. SO8234. Det. G.D. Kitchener 2019 R. maritimus – frequent, marshy lagoon, Longdon Marsh N.R., SO8234

Salix caprea x S. cinerea (Salix x reichardtii) – single tree, scrub, Frog End Meadow, Stoke Bliss, SO6563 (VC36 Worcs.)

S. x smithiana (S. viminalis x S. caprea) – single tree, waste ground, Penny Hill Quarry, Martley, SO7561

Scutellaria altissima – seeding and spreading, disused garden, FSC Bishops Wood, Crossway Green, SO8368. BW

 $\it Taxodium\ distichum - \ single\ small\ tree,\ side\ of\ footpath,\ Laughern\ Hill,\ SO7758$ 

Turritis glabra – 12 plants, railway sidings, Sandbourne, SO7974 Verbascum densiflorum – few plants, bank of dismantled railway, Sandbourne, SO7974

V. phlomoides – several scattered plants verge of B4090, Hanbury Wharf, SO9163

V. virgatum – c.50 plants, waste ground, Wilden Lane, Wilden, SO8273. Brett Westwood.

V. thapsus x V. virgatum (V. x lamaitrei) – single plant, roadside, Astley Burf, SO8161. Second county record.

V. bithynica - c.30 plants, hedgebank, Prickley, Hill Side, SO7562.

Vicia pannonica – introduced as part of stewardship scheme, Stanford Bridge, SO7165

V. sylvatica – few plants, Penny Hill Quarry, Martley, SO7561
