The discovery of a recently deceased bird or mammal is a moment of excitement and anticipation for the enthusiastic coleopterist. Below is an account of the beetle species recorded on a casual basis whenever the opportunity has arisen. I am fortunate to live in a cottage on the Shakenhurst estate in north-west Worcestershire close to the Shropshire border. Much of the estate is either semi-natural ancient woodland occupying steep-sided slopes alongside a series of small streams flowing into the River Rea, or agricultural land farmed for arable and mixed cattle/sheep grazing purposes. There are many veteran trees within some of the grazing pastures close to Shakenhurst Hall indicative of former 'pasture woodland' communities that once covered larger areas of the countryside than they do now. The veteran trees are predominately pedunculate oak, but there are also veteran ash and sweet chestnut trees.

Mammal corpses at varying stages of decay provide vital 'patch' habitats where a wide variety of insect species can feed and reproduce. Investigation of decaying corpses provides an opportunity to find species specially adapted to survive in such environments that would otherwise be difficult to locate. The following are some of the more interesting species I have recorded here to date.

Margarinotus merdarius (Hoffman, J., 1803) (Col; Histeridae). One collected from a dead fox. 14.5.2016.

Onthophagus coenobita (Herbst, 1783) (Col; Scarabaeidae). I was surprised to find a number of beetles from the Scarabaeidae normally associated with animal dung in decaying corpses. A single specimen of the localised *O.coenobita* was found in a dead carrion crow on 27.4.2016 and another was found in a dead pheasant on 17.5.2016.

Necrodes littoralis (Linnaeus, 1758) (Col; Silphidae). One under a dead fox on 30.4.2016. (No picture).

Nicrophorus vespilloides Herbst, 1783 (Col; Silphidae). One under a dead fox on 2.5.2016.

Oiceoptoma thoracicum (Linnaeus, 1758) (Col; Silphidae). One was in a dead pheasant on 17.7.2015. Several were under the remains of a dead fox on 23.4.2016. A search on NBN Gateway reveals few records for Worcestershire; but the few records are all from the north of the county.

Creophilus maxillosus (Linnaeus, 1758) (Col; Staphylinidae). Three were under a dead fox on 23.4.2016. A single specimen was under a dead carrion crow on 8.5.2016. A search on NBN Gateway reveals very few Worcestershire records for this impressive rove beetle.
