In September 2018 while going through one of my old files when I discovered the late Don Goddard's list of terrestrial invertebrates from Lyppard Grange in 1997. I knew he had made this list when we were dismantling the rubble of Lyppard Grange rescuing Great Crested Newts but apparently it has never reached the Worcestershire Biological Records Centre (WBRC).
